- He will be responsible for operating the funds under the Head of Accounts Indicated above and for monitoring the progress made by the various Departments/Undertakings periodically and submit his report to Government. He will chalkout details of the programmes, if necessary in consultation with Government, and release the amount to the agencies implementing the scheme.
- 7. The Departments concerned indicated in para 2 from whom Rs.30.16 crores have been taken for pooling shall send immediate proposals to Finance Department surrending the amount to Govt. without waiting for the closure of the financial year. Finance Department will release an equal amount from the contengency fund under the Heads indicated above.
- 8. The amount should be spent for the benefit of Sch. Castes only as per the guidelines issued by Government from time to time in respect of implementing Special Component Plan schemes.
